Port Regis is located in large private grounds near Shaftesbury in Dorset, two hours from London.






Age-appropriate activities

8 - 12 Year Olds

This course combines language lessons with fun activities, games, sports and trips for 8 - 12 year olds. There is a maximum of 60 children, with a staff:student ratio of 1:6. Boys and girls live in separate areas of a comfortable modern building in the school grounds, in single or double rooms. House parents create a warm, well-supervised environment where children will feel secure while they speak English and make new friends. There are excellent indoor and outdoor recreation areas suitable for the age group.





13 - 17 Year Olds

This course has around 70 teenagers from more than 20 different countries, with a 1:6 staff-student ratio. A balanced programme of lessons, workshops and fun activities allows teens to improve their English, make new friends, grow personally and relax. They stay in a modern boarding house with separate floors for boys and girls and house parents for support. Each has a private study bedroom with washbasin, desk and wardrobe. Shared rooms and girls-only accommodation are available on request. Comfortable relaxation areas offer space to enjoy free time speaking English together.

Effective English learning



On the first teaching day, students are assessed and placed in classes of up to 16 based on age and ability.

- International classes help students practice English and learn about different cultures.
- Attractive and engaging materials.
 'Bring the world to the classroom and the classroom to life.'
- Teachers skilled with younger children lead lessons for 8-10 year olds.
- Lessons for older children mix science, geography and history plus environmental projects to help them learn English naturally.

- Lessons for 13 17 year olds feature TED Talks to help students practice their presentation skills.
- Collaborative project work helps to build interpersonal skills.
- Songs, games, and music make learning fun and help students interact and move.
- Teachers rotate between classes to keep things interesting.
- Parents can track their child's progress with weekly online reports.
- Online English lessons are available for all ages outside the summer.

Pupils choose a different workshop each week.
Other workshops may include poetry, film making, songwriting, forest school and environmental studies.

Academic Workshops and Online English

Grammar and Pronunciation workshop

For students who have reached a plateau or want to improve specific English skills and learn the phonetic alphabet.

Course Journal workshop

Students become editors and journalists to create a weekly school journal. It helps them focus on writing content, style, and accuracy.

Digital photography workshop

Pupils learn to avoid common mistakes and take better photos. They develop their aesthetic sense while practising speaking and writing.

Drama workshop

Pupils create, rehearse, and perform short plays, boosting their linguistic confidence.

Cookery workhop

Students learn cooking basics, hygiene, and safety. They compete to be 'master chef' and develop independent living skills.

Optional Sports Coaching: Four hours of sports lessons per week are available at extra charge with qualified instructors for all ability levels as follows:

Golf: Lessons on the school's own course include chipping, driving, tee shots and bunker play. Maximum of 8 pupils per instructor.

Tennis: Lessons include fun exercises to develop agility, balance, coordination, strength, speed and technical skill. Maximum of 8 pupils per instructor.



Stonehenge

World-famous Stonehenge is around 40 minutes from the school. Educational tours are available for all pupils at a cost of £45 including transport.

London Weekend

To really see this great city we arrange a 2-night visit for teenagers 13 – 17. The cost includes bed and breakfast twin-room accommodation in a good hotel close to the main tourist sights, Thames river tour, packed lunches, two evening meals and transport by train between London and the school. Supervision is by our own teachers with a staff:pupil ratio of at least 1:6

Course fees include

- Accommodation at the school with all meals, weekly laundry, use of sporting, academic, and recreational facilities.
- Fully international, British Council Accredited, agespecific courses with maximum 5 boys and 5 girls in each age group with the same mother tongue.

Taxi transfers

We offer escorted transfers from London Heathrow or Gatwick for students arriving after 5PM or leaving before noon, or travelling via other airports/stations. The cost is about GBP 360, less for children travelling together, more for children travelling as Unaccompanied Minors or at unsocial hours. Contact us for details.

Please note

If possible we will connect parents so that children can travel together. We recommend young children travel as Unaccompanied Minors in the care of airline staff. We can't provide accommodation in the school before or after summer school.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Accuracy of Details

Booking details must be accurate. We may ask for ID like a passport to confirm a child's age and identity. If proof isn't provided or details are significantly wrong, we can remove the child without a refund.

Deposit Payment

To secure your booking, pay a non-refundable GBP 350 deposit within 10 days. If not paid, the place will be offered to other students.

The balance

This is payable six weeks before your child attends. For bookings made less than 6 weeks before attending, the full fee is payable within 10 days. Any fees unpaid after 14 days from the invoice date will result in cancellation.

Cancellation & withdrawal

No refunds if a child cancels after June 1st, or misses or leaves a course. Written cancellations before June 1st may get a partial or full refund if we can fill the vacancy. Depending on the reason, you might be able to reclaim losses from our insurers.

Exclusion

We can send a child home at any time, at the parent or guardian's expense, for their best interest or if their behaviour harms the school. Reasons may include - but are not limited to - severe incontinence, self-harm, alcohol or drug use, repeated smoking, and bullying.

Changes to the programme

We publish programme details in good faith but may change any part of the course if needed.
